EKLIPSE aims to establish and follow an ethical infrastructure for all its main activities, thus strengthening recognition and transparency of its processes. As such, EKLIPSE's ethical infrastructure builds on many lessons learned from other interface processes, scientific quality assurance and engagement issues coming from transdisciplinary research.

This declaration of Conflict of Interest corresponds to measure 4 in the 13 measures and instruments planned in building EKLIPSE Ethical Infrastructure (see www.eclipse-mechanism.eu). The form has been developed based on a review of existing documents with the same intention from other organisations. This includes the Conflict of Interest policies of BiodivERsA (for evaluation of proposals), UNEP (a general Col policy) and IPCC and IPBES (both for experts engaging in their work). As IPBES in its approach is closely related to the work of EKLIPSE in this area, the form is based strongly on the according IPBES form (see: IPBES/3/3, Annex II, page 19 in:

Introduction to the declaration of conflict of interest

You have been invited to bring in your professional standing and expertise into the work of the EKLIPSE mechanism. As outlined in the EKLIPSE ethical infrastructure guidelines, your role demands special attention to issues of conflict of interest and bias in order to respect and maintain the credibility and relevance of your working group and of EKLIPSE processes and their products. Thus, disclosure of certain matters is necessary to ensure that the work of EKLIPSE is not compromised. We rely on your professionalism, common sense and honesty in filling out this form. We do not ask for comprehensive lists of activities under each heading set out below. You should disclose interests that are relevant and relate or have the appearance of relating to your role in EKLIPSE work by:

1. Impairing your objectivity in carrying out your work
2. Creating an advantage for you, your family, close relatives, personal friends or organization you have been working for.

For the purposes of this policy, circumstances that could lead a reasonable person to question your objectivity, or whether an advantage has been created, constitute a potential conflict of interest and should be disclosed on this form. Disclosure of an interest on this form does not automatically mean that a conflict exists or that you will be unable to perform your designated role in EKLIPSE. If you are in any doubt about whether an interest should be disclosed, you are encouraged to disclose such interest, so it can be checked by the Knowledge Coordination Body of EKLIPSE.
